BATH MEETING HOUSE



The Bath Meeting House stands on the banks of the St. John River with the Trans-Canada Trail at its rear. Built in 1904 as a Methodist church, the simple wooden building now serves the area as a historic venue with art exhibits, local artisan products for sale and displays of historical Carleton County photographs. Music concerts are performed weekly in Summer and a Canada Day celebration has become a tradition.

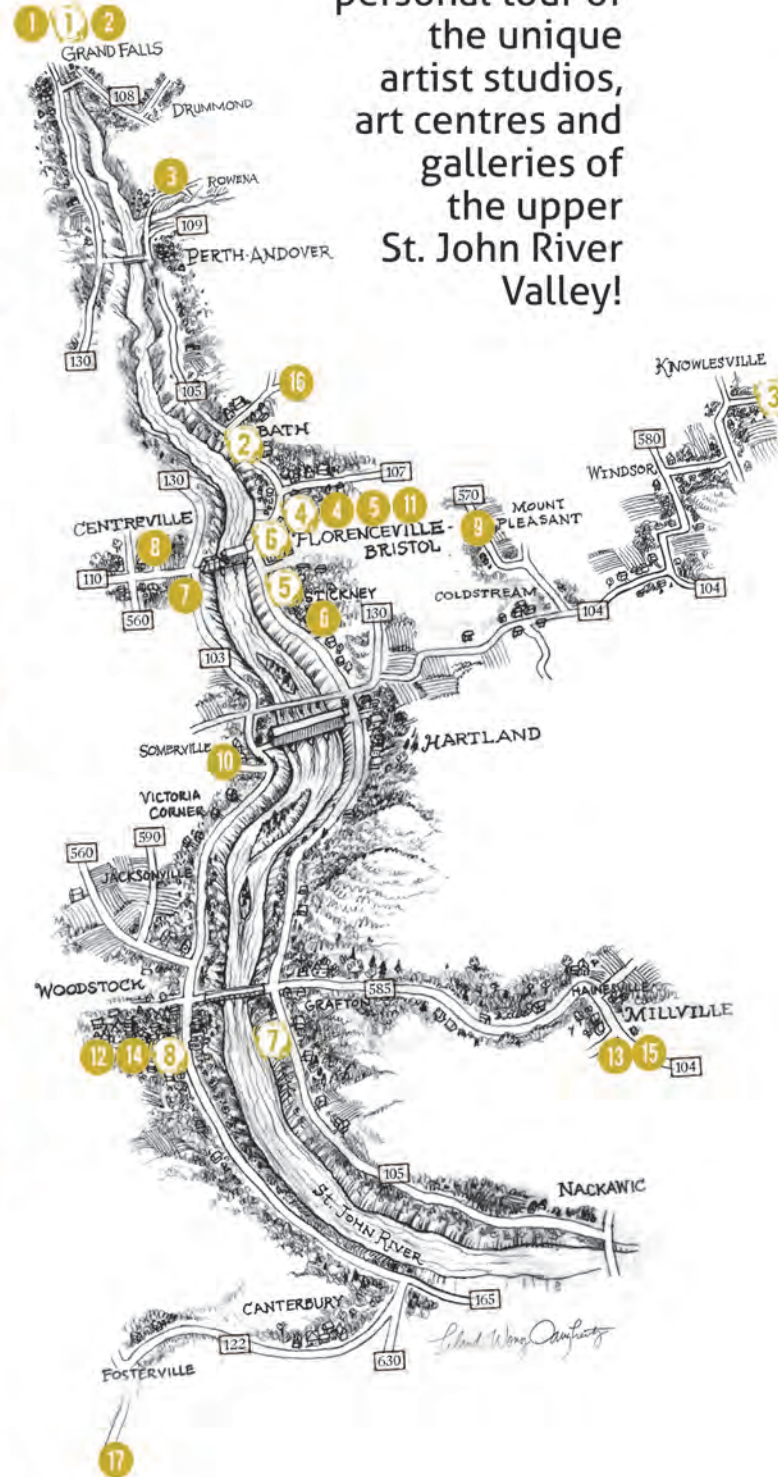
